

To further limit office visits, MVD customers are urged to go to <u>www.servicearizona.com</u>, Many online services will use the AZ MVD Now application through ServiceArizona. All current Arizona MVD customers already have an AZ MVD Now account and simply need to activate it.

To set up your secure, personal online access you will need: Internet access; Your AZ Driver License OR the VIN number from a vehicle you have registered in the State of Arizona; Have a Social Security Number. All payments for services conducted on AZ MVD Now require a credit card. For assistance, you may call a statewide customer service line at 602-712-2700 between 7:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. Before you call this line, please visit ServiceArizona.com and access your AZ MVD Now account for faster service.
